All guests are greeted by our team at the 4 Eagle Ranch Carriage House, located at the entrance of the property adjacent to the parking lot. You will be checked in and given a tour of the property by one of our on-retreat team members.

Free guest parking is available at 4 Eagle Ranch, just a 10-15 minute walk from the tents. Note: Please wear sturdy shoes for the walk between the parking lot and your accommodations, as the trail is uphill and slightly rugged.

THE WEATHER

Colorado weather is fairly mild, though can be unpredictable at times. Summer and fall generally bring temperate days with bright blue skies, occasional rain showers, and brisk evenings and early mornings due to the elevation. Each tent has a plush down comforter on the bed, which we'll also provide with extra blankets in case the temperature drops significantly at night. We recommend checking the forecast for Vail, CO, prior to your arrival and bringing warm, waterproof layers to account for potential swings in temperature and precipitation. A full packing list is below.

DON'T FORGET TO HYDRATE

The elevation of Vail, CO, is 8,022 feet. Avoid the potential for dizziness or mild headaches by drinking extra water on your way to the retreat.

THE COLLECTIVE PACKING LIST

We have a relaxed and casual environment at Collective Vail, so no need to bring fancy clothing or footwear. Here are some items that may come in handy during your stay:

- Sturdy sneakers or boots for uneven, sometimes muddy ground
- Light layers such as short-sleeved shirts and dresses for warmer days
- Warm layers such as thick socks, coat or fleece, and cozy pajamas in case of cool evenings. Bathrobes are, of course, provided.
- Slippers
- Waterproof jacket and shoes
- Sunglasses, hat, and sunblock
- Face moisturizer and lip balm—it gets dry!
- Water bottle and a small backpack for daytime activities or hikes
- Ear plugs or sleep mask, in the case of a mid-day nap
- Camera, books, or a travel journal
- Your favorite creative outlet for when you feel inspired (ex: drawing, needlework, etc.)

DINING AT COLLECTIVE VAIL

Note: We ask that you reserve all lunches and dinners (including boxed lunches) in advance so that our chefs are prepared to deliver an exceptional experience for you. Please contact our concierge at (970) 445-2033 or concierge@collectiveretreats.com with any final dining requests at least 48 hours prior to your arrival. There is also beer, wine, and liquor available for purchase at the retreat to our guests ages 21+.

Here is an overview of our dining offerings:

BREAKFAST

Full-service breakfast is complimentary with a stay in one of our Summit Tents and is available for purchase for guests staying in our Journey Tents. Breakfast is served at Three Peaks Lodge each morning from 8 a.m.—10 a.m. and includes a seasonal mix of hearty and healthy options.

LUNCH

We offer lunch daily, which can be enjoyed at your tent or packed to go. Lunch options include a salad or sandwich of your choice, a seasonal side, and tasty dessert. Each comes with a side of fresh, seasonal fruit and shortbread pecan sandies.

DINNER

Farm to Table Dinner

Each evening, our chef creates a multi-course menu that can be enjoyed at Three Peaks Lodge or at outdoor tables under the stars. This is a guest favorite for good reason, and we highly encourage booking at least one during your stay. Our menu varies, so if you choose to schedule more than one farm to table dinner, you'll be sure to have a unique experience each night.
