## WELCOME TO COLLECTIVE YELLOWSTONE, A RETREAT AT MOONLIGHT BASIN

### GETTING HERE

Collective Yellowstone is located in the exclusive Moonlight Basin community, nine miles from Big Sky Town Center. We're about a 1-hour drive on Hwy 191 from both Bozeman and Yellowstone Airports, with a scenic pass through the vast Gallatin Canyon. We recommend renting a car with 4WD, so you'll be able to explore the area as thoroughly as you'd like. Our concierge can also assist in arranging transportation for certain activities and day trips to Yellowstone National Park.

### UPON ARRIVAL

**CHECK-IN: 2 P.M.**

**CHECKOUT: 11 A.M.**

All guests are greeted by our team at the parking lot adjacent to Three Peaks Lodge. You will be checked in and given a tour of the property by one of our on-retreat team members.

Free guest parking is available at the retreat, just a 5-minute walk from the tents. Note: Please wear sturdy shoes for the walk between the parking lot and your accommodations, as the trail is uphill and slightly rugged.



### THE WEATHER

Moonlight Basin weather can be unpredictable at times but fall generally brings cool temperatures with bright blue skies during the day and brisk evenings. The tents stay warm at night with the wood-burning stoves and plush down comforters on the beds. We recommend checking the forecast for Big Sky, MT prior to your arrival and bringing waterproof footwear and warm outer layers to account for potential swings in temperature and precipitation. 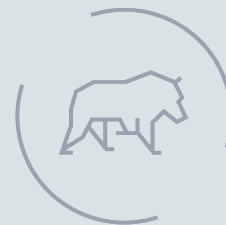

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## THE COLLECTIVE PACKING LIST

We have a relaxed and casual environment at Collective Yellowstone, so no need to bring fancy clothing or footwear. Here are some items that may come in handy during your stay:

- Sturdy sneakers or boots for uneven, sometimes muddy ground
- Extra layers for sleeping at night, in case the temperatures drop
- Warm layers such as thick socks, coat or fleece, and cozy pajamas in case of cool evenings. Bathrobes are, of course, provided.
- Slippers
- Waterproof jacket and shoes
- Sunglasses, hat, and sunblock
- Face moisturizer and lip balm—it gets dry!
- Water bottle and a small backpack for daytime activities or hikes
- Ear plugs or sleep mask, in the case of a mid-day nap
- Two... make that three additional bottles of your favorite wine (alcohol is not served at the retreat)
- Camera, books, or a travel journal
- Your favorite creative outlet for when you feel inspired (ex: drawing, needlework, etc.)
