Manhattan ferry (10 South Street Ferry Terminal):

Weekdays: 10 a.m.-4:15 p.m.

Weekends: 10 a.m.-6 p.m.

Brooklyn ferry (Pier 6 at Brooklyn Bridge Park):

Weekends ONLY: 11 a.m.-5:30 p.m.

On Island Guest Shuttling

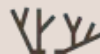
Weekdays, except when Governors Island is open for Late Night: 5-7 p.m.

PET POLICY

While we love pets, unfortunately they are not allowed on Governors Island, and therefore may not join you at the retreat.

FOR SAFETY & SECURITY REASONS

Public use of Governors Island is not permitted at night. Guests must stay within retreat grounds once the island closes, where there will be evening activities such as movie nights, lawn games, and delicious eats. Guests who go outside the retreat will be fined \$100.

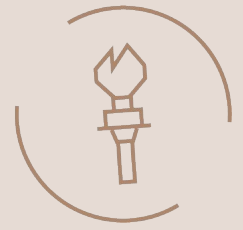
The island is closed:

ATTIRE: ISLAND CASUAL

- Toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, etc.
Bath products are available on-retreat
