Manhattan ferry (10 South Street Ferry Terminal):

Weekdays: 10 a.m.-4:15 p.m.

Weekends: 10 a.m.-6 p.m.

Brooklyn ferry (Pier 6 at Brooklyn Bridge Park):

Weekends ONLY: 11 a.m.-5:30 p.m.

On Island Guest Shuttling

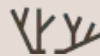
Weekdays, except when Governors Island is open for Late Night: 5-7 p.m.

## FOR SAFETY & SECURITY REASONS

Public use of Governors Island is not permitted at night. Guests must stay within retreat grounds once the island closes, where there will be evening activities such as movie nights, lawn games, and delicious eats. Guests who go outside the retreat will be fined \$100.

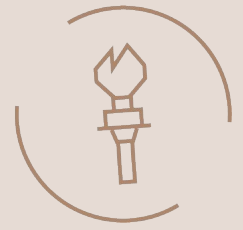
The island is closed:

- Hot and cold options available through the week (\$25/adult; \$15/child under 12)

- 10 a.m.-5 p.m., sit down or to-go
- Dozens of eateries and vendors on the island

### DINNER AT THREE PEAKS

- Daily, 6-9 p.m.
- Shareables start at 5 p.m.
- Small bites and full meal options

### BBQ-IN-A-BOX

- \$25-\$50 depending on selection
- Ready-to-grill main course and sides
- Grilling accoutrements
- Table settings

### FARM & FISHERMAN CHEF DINNER

- 3-course Prix Fixe, \$75 per
- 6-course Prix Fixe, \$150 per
- Sommelier wine pairing available, \$75
